The Beamer Hughes Foundation, a 501(c) not-for-profit charitable organization, is named in honor of: Thomas H. (Beamer) Hughes II (1956-2008). Beamer's closest friends established the Foundation in 2003 as a tribute to his caring and generous spirit. The Foundation's mission is to help people from the Greater Rochester/Finger Lakes Region that are affected with muscular dystrophy secure the necessary equipment and support services. Beamer, along with his wife, Stephanie and his friends began fund-raising efforts while he was fighting the devastating effects of muscular dystrophy himself. Since its inception, the Foundation has raised over \$500,000 to help people with muscular dystrophy obtain the equipment and support services they need to live. The dollars raised stay here to help people affected with muscular dystrophy who live in Genesee, Livingston, Monroe, Ontario, Orleans, Seneca, and Yates counties. Services include:

- Patient services at the Neuromuscular Disease Clinic located at the University of Rochester Medical Center
- Purchase of stair, bed and pool lifts, specialized chairs, and commodes
- Vehicle modifications
- Purchase of wheelchairs, power chairs, and leg braces
- Purchase of communication devices
- Summer Camp Program for children (ages 6 to 21) with muscular dystrophy. Locally, the camp is held annually at the Rotary Sunshine Campus in Rush, New York.
- Support groups to assist children, adults, and families affected with muscular dystrophy
- Public and professional education sessions

In addition to helping children and adults with specific equipment needs, The Beamer Hughes Foundation also makes a generous donation to Muscular Dystrophy Association (MDA) each year at the MDA telethon. Two quotes for all requests are required for consideration. Insurance company payments, grants, etc., are searched out and accounted for so that The Beamer Hughes Foundation can continue to help as many people as possible.
